- They.... waiting for hours.
- I've gardening. It's so nice out there.
- She reading that book all day.
- The grass looks wet. it been raining?
- I've been gardening for three hours. (garden) My back is killing me!
- Tony has been listening to the news non-stop since the conflict began. (listen)
- Have you been saving the coupons for me? (save)
- Rogerat his mother's house since his divorce. (stay)
- How long the dogs like that? (bark)
- Ithe football score. (not follow) Are we winning?
- The students plans for the school party for several weeks. (make)
- Rachelat that studio for very long. (not dance)
